To Whom It May Concern:

First, on behalf of the Cree Nation Government, it is the sincere wish of the Cree Nation Government that all participants in the mining industry of Eeyou Istchee, including their families and loved ones remain safe during these very trying times of the Coronavirus pandemic.

Eeyou Istchee has thankfully been spared the status of other regions characterized by an alarming number of COVID-19 cases and widespread community transmission. Resident leadership, community members, business and the Public Health authority have worked very hard to keep COVID-19 to a minimum due to the inherent vulnerabilities of the region's population and geographically dispersed health care system. The Cree Nation is willing to receive guests in Eeyou Istchee to pursue their economic development aspirations or other governance-type activities, providing that such guests adapt their procedures and protocols to protect themselves and neighboring communities from the Coronavirus.
